Hugo de Chafecombe (1002)

The Rev. Henry Barbour in a letter to the writer about his book on the British Surnames (Nov. 3rd 1891) asserts the the Chafys were of Norman extraction; and another antiquary assured him that their English founder was Hugo, steward of Emma of Normandy, in whose train he came to England in 1002 when he wedded Ethelred II, and that he then became established at Chafecombe in Somerset, remaining undisturbed throughout the conflict of dynasties, Saxon Danish and Norman, owing to his allegiance to each, under his royal mistress who, after Elhelred the saxon's death, became the wife of Knut the Dane, and was mother of the semi saxon Norman King, Edward the Confessor.

Notes for Reginald Fitz-Hugu:

Reginald "Fitz-Hugo" is shown by the Domesday record to have been joint owner of the "vill of Chaffecumbe on the day King Edward was alive and dead," around 5th January, 1065-66. He had also a separate manor in that parish, and other lands, quite independently of his joint holding.

Notes for Red Ralph Fitz-Reginald Fitz-Hugu:

"Read" Ralph, Fitz-Reginald Fitz Hugh to continue the tenancy, although under the newly devised feudal system the tenant was practically the owner.

At the Norman conquest King William gave the whole of the Chafecombe property to his Chief Justiciary and powerful favourite, Jeffery, Bishop of Coutance, in Normandy, who, however, permitted "Ralph Fitz-Reginald" to succeed his father in the "whole township" as "sub-tenant."

Ralph was succeeded by his son Robert Fitz-Ralph who held lands worth £20. in capite of Henry I., by the service of one Knight's fee. The name Hugh, Reginald, Ralph, Robert etc. sufficiently attest to the Norman extraction of the family. According to the black book of the Exchequer, Roberts son Ranulph, Fitz-Robert was seised of the manor lands of and the town of Chafecombe, and of the perpetual advowson and right of presentation to the church, in the time of Stephen holding in capite of the King 1135.

The latter's son, Robert Fitz-Ralph, succeeded to the lands held by his ancestor, Reginald Fitz-Hugh, and is described as "Lord of Chaffecumbe," and as holding lands of the King-in-Chief to the value of one knight's fee, in the reign of Henry I.

From the "Black Book of the Exchequer," Ranulph Fitz-Robert, owned the manor lands together with the town of Chafecombe and the perpetual advowson and right of presentation to the parish church in the following reign, and that the Lord of Chafecombe in the time of Henry II was Robert Fitz-Ranulph, who had a younger brother known as Ranulph Fitz Ranulph.

Ranulf de Chafecombe. 2 Ranulf Fitz-Ranulf, younger brother of Robert, and Uncle of Agnes, kept up the male line, and to him his father gave a carucate of land as a younger son's portion, in the time of Henry II. 1281 he had a son Robert, who interpleaded in the law suit quoted, and was plaintiff in a plea of law in 1281, in or about which year he did. His son was Thomas Chafe de Chafecombe..

Notes for Lady of Chaffecumbe Agnes:

Robert, Lord of Chafecombe, had an only child, Agnes, who was "Lady of Chaffecumbe" in her own right. By her first husband,

who bore the well-known Devonshire name of Avenel, she had two daughters, co-heirs, Emma and Margery. She married secondly one of the Justices in Eyre, John de Aure, and had by him a third daughter, Margaret, and a son, John de Aure, who died in his mother's lifetime and without issue.

Agnes de Chafecombe 1200.

Agnes de Chafecombe was seised of the manor of Chafecombe, Lillesdon and Wendestie, and the advowsons of Chafecombe and Wendestie, and presented to the churches of Chafecombe and Wendestie in the time of Henry III. She married (1) Oliver Avenel, who held Chafecombe (in the right of his wife) of the Abbot of Forde by the service of £1.3.4 yearly under King John. Her children were also daughters (1) Emma., who succeeded to one half the manor and advowson of Chafecombe etc. and held one hide in Chafecombe of the Abbot of Forde at the annual rent of 20/-. She married Jordan de Insula (des L'Insole) by whom she had a son and heir Walter de Insula, who was 14 at his grandmother's death. (2) Marjorie, who succeeded to the other half of the manor and advowson of Chafecombe etc. and was twice married.. (1) to Warren de Noveton who died without issue: (2) to Philip de Cantilupe, by whom she had a son, Bladeric de Cantilupe.

Agnes married (2) John de Aure, one of the Kings Justices itinerant living in 1263, by whom she had a son and two daughters:- John de Aure, died in his mother's lifetime. Margart..Elizabeth, died unmarried. Margaret inherited the manor and ad vovdon of Wendestie and married de-Acton, by whom she had two sons, John de Acton, who died in his mother's lifetime, and Odo de Acton who became heir to his brother john, and claimed the right of presentation to Wendestie against Roger de Moeles, gardian of Idonea in 1295.

Notes for Thomas Chafe de Chafecombe:

The son of Robert Fitz-Ranulph is especially noteworthy as being the first of the family who assumed a regular surname, which was of course, derived from his property. As "Thomas Chafe" of Chafecombe, he was seized of land "of the inheritance of Robert, his father." He married Matilda, daughter of Andrew de Bosco (Anglice, Boys) of Knolle Co. Somerset, and died in 1281. His widow recovered the custody of his son and heir, Thomas Chafe, against a certain cleric known as William de St. Esprit, in 1284.

This Thomas de Chafecombe was the first to assume the surname, and was seised of a hide of land etc. at Chafecombe "in inheritance of his father" robert Fitz Ranulf:..He married Matilda daughter of Andrew de Bosco (Bois, anglisce Boys, Boyce (Wood) of Cnolle, co. Somerset, to whom Margaret daughter of Matilda de Chafecombe, gave a virgate of land at Chafecombe, by fine in 1246-1282. He died about 1283.

Thomas Chafe of Chafecombe married Christina, daughter and heir of Knolle Co. Somerset, youngest son of Geoffry de Magna Villa (Steward of Normandy in right of his mother, Margaret, daughter of Eudo Dapifer), by his wife Rohesia, daughter of the Chief justice of England Alberic de Vere Geoffry de Magna Villa was the first Earl of Essex so created by King Stephen and confirmed by the Empress Maud. He was afterwards in rebellion against the King and plundered the abbeys of St. Albans and Ramsey; ultimately, during a raid on a Kentish castle, he was shot through the head with an arrow, having discarded his helmet in consequence of the heat of the sun. His granddaughter, Christina Chafe, seems to have been dowered with lands in Somerset since known as Kingston Mandevill, and which were sold by her husband in or about the year 1310. She had two sons, the youngest being called Andrew.

The son and heir of Thomas de Chafecombe, who was underage in 1285 and was seised of this father's lands in Chafecombe and elsewhere, married Christina, daughter of Robert de Mandeville, a younger branch of Mandevilles (Earls of Essex) and they sold conjointly divers lands of her inheritance in Kingston Mandeville co. Somerset. About 1311 they had two sons, Thomas and Andrew. The elder son Thomas Chafe de Chafecombe, who was under age in 1316, held lands and tenements at Chafecombe of the Earl of Gloucester and Hereford by military services. He died before 1363, and having no son his possession passed to his three daughters, Johnna, Agnes and Elizabeth, and thus once more the estate, or what was left of it drifted away to females.

He alone remained to perpetuate the name; and quitting the cradle of his race, became as Prince says of Thomas Risdon who was also a younger brother, "the hammerman of his fortune" carrying with him little besides the memory of his ancient home and lineage.

Andrew Chafe, seized of lands in Chafecumbe, seems to have died at Bridgewater subsequently to 1375,

John seems to have resided at Ilminster, and was the father of Richard "Chafy" of Sherborne, Dorset, who was also seized of the Somersetshire property in 1522, in which year he died.

A Richard Chafy is given to him as a son who has lands and tenements in Somerset and Dorset, and in the latter County of Sherbourne, where he paid the subsidy in 1522 and died in the following year. He is the first Chafy known to own property in Dorset.

William Chaffe of Wellington (Wellington registers begin in 1683. Those of West Buckland, which was annexed to Wellington in 1552) the ascertained ancestor of the Devonshire branch, who charged their arms with a crescent, shewing they considered themselves a second house. He married Johe or Johanne (surname unknown) who was buried at Wellington.

William Chaffe, the undoubted ancestor and founder of the Devonshire Branch Exeter branch, was seised of lands in Sherbourne and Holwell, co. Dorset, and co. Wellington co. Somerset on which he paid subsidies 14 & 15 Henry VIII. He lived in Wellington and his wife's name was Jone or Johanna.

Worthy described William's line. William Chaffie lived in Wellington (18 miles northwest of Chaffecombe) and had two sons, Robert and Nicholas. Nicholas' sons Peter and William (married Jone) acquired land at Buckfastleigh and still held it in 1660. Robert moved to Exeter and was mayor there two times 1568/9 and 1576/7 (co-mayor with Thomas Prestwode) and also a member of the Guild of Merchant Venturers. He died at Exeter in 1580 and his will says he was born in Wellington. He had five sons and two daughters. Sons Robert and George were living at Exeter in 1605 and 1611. Son Richard, died in 1596.

Rev. John Chafy: (1719-1782) Born in Lillington Dorset. John was the son of Rev. John Chafie (1686-1757). His father became the rector of Purse Caundle (c.1731). John Sr. may have changed his surname to Chafy around that time. John Jr. was educated at Eton and matriculated from Kings College in 1738. The famous English landscape and portrait artist Thomas Gainsborough (1727-1788) painted a portrait John Chafy in his early thirties (c.1572) and probably still a bachelor - The Rev. John Chafy Playing the Violoncello in a Landscape. Chafy, who was the vicar at Great Bricett in Suffolk at the time, was also talented amateur musician. Gainsborough was known to have played several instruments with 'native skill' and was an active member of the Ipswich Musical Club. In the temple behind John is a statue holding a lyre, the attribute of the Muses of dancing and love poetry. This is probably a reference to Chafy's forthcoming marriage to Ann Gisborne, a rich heiress with an estate located in Hilton, Derby. Rev. William Chafy: (1779-1843) Born in Canterbury. Grandson of Rev. John Chafy (1719-1788). In 1778 he was admitted a King's Scholar at the Kings School. In 1796 he graduated Cambridge. He was Master of Sidney Sussex College, Cambridge. Chafy was made Vice Chancellor of Cambridge University and married Mary Westwood in 1813. The controversial, over-bearing and dynamic Master William Chafy invited the famous architect Sir Jeffrey Wyatt (1766-1840), in 1813 to refurbish the buildings which had been described in 1814 as 'gloomy'. Wyatt later went on to build St George's Hall at Windsor Castle. William married Mary Westwood in 1813 at Twickenham. His son William Westwood Chafy was born in 1814. That same year he was appointed Chaplain in Ordinary to George III and later George IV. In 1822 he was granted the Chafy coat of arms by the Earl Marshall of England. In 1829 he bought an estate of 533 acres in the hamlet of Sheriff's Lench, Worcestershire. In 1831 he was appointed Chaplain in Ordinary to William IV and later Queen Victoria. It appears he had correspondence with Charles Darwin (1809-1882) at some point in this career. The diaries of William Westwood's son, Rev. William Kyle Westwood Chafy (1841-1916), describe the genealogy of the Chaffe surname in England. The Diaries of the Chafes or Chafys of Chafe-Combe, Exeter and Sherborne were published in 1910. W.K.W. married Mary Clara Shirley in 1872 and had two sons and four daughters.
